#### Good News stories:

- One student achieved 7 GCSEs at Grade 5+ including 3 grade 8's.
- Increase number of pupils completing Arts award.
- Statistics GCSE offered for the first time. 2 Students gained grade 5's.
- English results improved with three students gaining grades at or above grade 7.
- Biology results have improved with more students gaining grades at grade 4+
- Improved number of students achieving Arts Award.
- Increased range of TPP qualifications achieved by students including Mechanics and Construction
- All grades were approved by exam board moderators. Highlighting high level in-house moderation processes.

#### Destinations:

- Students have been supported through their Post-16 choices with the support from our Careers Adviser.
- 3 students have gained employment
  - 3 students have gained apprenticeship
  - 11 students are attending either Suffolk One or Suffolk New College
  - 4 students continued to be supported by Young Persons Workers (YPWs) with transition choices.
