After the launch, a series of FREE Workshops run by clinicians and specialist teachers for partner schools for the Autumn Term 2020 will be published.

Training is led and delivered jointly by colleagues from the Raedwald Trust serving as MNIS – Suffolk alongside MNIS – Oxon. We are committed to supporting Children with Medical Needs in Suffolk and beyond.

By signing up to the project you will be able to:

- * gain valuable knowledge and practical support to support your pupils with medical (including mental health) needs
- * ensure you are compliant in DfE statutory and best practice guidance
- * attend a programme of free training (specialist workshop sessions on specific medical needs pertinent to your pupils)
- * benefit from a local and national network of partnership with schools, health professionals, hospital schools etc
- * attend training that will provide a lasting impact on your school through helping to build capacity and develop your pathways, including access to a free Mental Health First Aid Training session (MHFA) – certifying one member of staff for each school (RPR£300 per delegate)
- * further develop ideas and communication around children with medical needs
