

Coronavirus related absences quick reference guide – 6th August 2020

What to do if...	Action needed	Code	Return to the centres when...
...my child has coronavirus symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come into the centres • Contact your centre daily • Self-isolate • Get a test • Inform us immediately about test result 	Code X	...the test comes back negative.
...my child tests positive for coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to the centres • Contact the centres daily • Self-isolate for at least 10 days • Inform the centres immediately about test result 	Code I	...they feel better. They can return to the centres after 10 days even if they have a cough or loss of smell/taste. These symptoms can last for several weeks once the infection is gone.
...somebody in my household has coronavirus symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to the centres • Contact the centres daily • Self-isolate • Household member to get a test • Inform the centres immediately about test result 	Code X	...the household member test is negative.
...somebody in my household has tested positive for coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to the centres • Contact the centres daily • Self-isolate for 14 days 	Code X	...the child has completed 14 days of self-isolation
... NHS test and trace have identified my child as a 'close contact' of somebody with symptoms or confirmed coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to the centres • Contact the centres daily • Self-isolate for 14 days 	Code X	...the child has completed 14 days of self-isolation
...we/my child travelled and has to self-isolate a part of a period of quarantine	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not take unauthorised leave in term time • Consider quarantine requirements and advice when booking travel • Provide information to the centres • <u>Returning from a destination where quarantine is needed:</u> • Do not come to the centres • Contact the centres daily • Self-isolate for 14 days 	Code X	...the quarantine period of 14 days has been completed
...we have received medical advice that my child must resume shielding.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to the centres • Contact the centres so that alternative arrangements can be made • Shield until you are informed that restrictions are lifted/shielding is paused again/medics tell you that it is safe for your child to return 	Code X	...the centres inform you that restrictions have been lifted and your child can return to the centres again.
