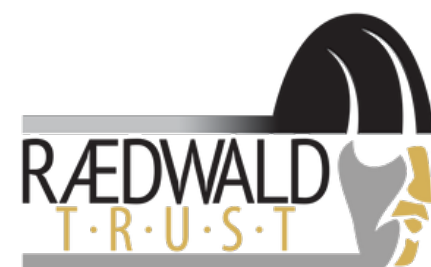

Pathways Explained

Springboard Pathway

- Pupil will attend a Raedwald Trust setting for two days a week for 12 weeks.
- On the other three days they will attend, at least 2 hours a day, at their mainstream setting.
- Outreach session will be delivered in mainstream setting for 1 hour a week
- Supports personal, social and emotional development alongside behaviour concerns
- Short term, early intervention for pupils who will successfully reintegrate fulltime to mainstream
- EHCP not required for placement

Building Pathway

- Pupil will attend a Raedwald Trust setting for a 19 week placement
- Weeks 1-15: 4 days a week
- Weeks 16 and 17: 3 days a week
- Week 18 and 19: 2 days a week
- Outreach session will be delivered in mainstream setting for 1 hour a week
- Supports personal, social and emotional development alongside behaviour concerns
- More intense intervention for pupils who likely will successfully reintegrate fulltime to mainstream
- EHCP not required for placement

Focused Pathway

- Pupil will attend a Raedwald Trust setting for 1-6 terms (to be agreed at point of admission) during KS4.
- Pupils will have the potential to access a mainstream curriculum, but need a more intensive and in some cases longer intervention to overcome significant barriers to learning/complete their GCSE study.
- A Key Stage 4 offer that provides access to a breadth of GCSEs and vocational /functional skills qualifications combined with pastoral and IAG support to best prepare each young person to be successful post-16.

How to make a referral

- Referrals are accepted and placements can begin at any point throughout the academic year
